2. ALUMNI PROGRAMS

Entries should reflect good planning, careful budgeting, and use of available resources, as well as the link between the program(s) and the alumni association and the program's impact on both the institution and the alumni association. Programs that may be entered include homecoming, reunions, regional programs: clubs/chapters/branches, alumni boards, campus/constituent groups, and parent programs, along with alumni education, community service, career assistance, awards, alumni admissions, legislative advocacy, technology applications, membership dues programs, new program initiatives, student advancement programs, and international alumni programs.

All entries must include a brief abstract (maximum of 2 pages) outlining components of the program and how they support your mission/overall advancement goals, overall program description, goals and objectives, planning, and results. Include budget and staffing information.
